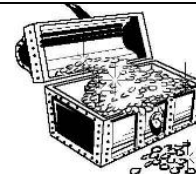

Message Summary for Sunday 4TH January 2004

“His & Heirs”

1. All we now experience and will experience of Jesus and our Salvation springs from the eternal purposes of God, rooted in the Godhead before time began!
2. The first part of the eternal purpose was this, that the Father should create, and He should create through the Son, the Word of God, in great power and wisdom.
3. Christ being the creator, is regarded by the Father as the Firstborn of creation, not that which was created first, who then went on to create what we see, But rather, because of what he has created, He receives a title of excellence, pre-eminence, and so is the rightful heir.
4. At the fall we lost a good kingdom, but in Christ, we have gained a far better one.
5. The eternal purposes of God are unfolded throughout the scriptures. We are children of the promise, ratified by an oath. We are Abraham's seed by faith, and yet Christ is THE SEED of Abraham, through whom all the nations of the earth shall be blest.
6. The object of our faithful vision is a Kingdom, of which the capital city is the place where God is, it is the inheritance of the saints in light, called “the sons of his Love.”
7. We are called the Sons of His love, because we possess a kingdom, in which we are joint heirs with Christ. All is ours, now and in the age to come. So let us here and now possess the world, for our enjoyment, without being possessed by it.
8. All things are ours in the age to come as well, think on it. GLORY, GLORY DWELLETH IN IMMANUELS LAND. So let us Measure our possessions and pursuits on earth, Match them with our possession in Christ and our pursuit of Christ and WEIGH them on the scales of passion. How much are we truly gripped by Christ, or inheritance in Him,? How much is our desire for Him and for Heaven our eternal home?

Some Key Texts:- Ephesians 3:8-11, Heb 11:3, Prov 8:22-25, John 3:35-36, John 16:15 John 17:1-5, Gal 3:29, James 2:5, Num 18:20, 2 Cor 6:9-10, Ps 42:1,27

1. Heaven? How does it impact on you today? Together make a list of how heaven, your eternal home, has changed your life. 10 things then beginning, “Because Heaven is my home I...?”

3. What drives you in our life to do the things you do? What are your top seven motivating forces? Split into two groups; make a list of seven each. Come back together and compare.
4. Remember Question 1? What is your honest opinion of the list of ten things you have made? If you were an unbeliever, looking at the list, would you think the apprehension of heaven found in the list, was worthy enough to make you think of wanting to go there?
5. Remember Question 3? Are there any motivating forces listed there, that you would not expect an unbeliever to list?

7. If you were to remove the gifts of the Holy Spirit, and the fruit of the Holy Spirit. What other indicators would there be to show you were a Christian
